

City of Grand Island Adopt-A-Park/Trail Program Application

1. The Adopting organization commits to a one-year period of adoption. At the end of the year organization can renew, change sections or terminate. If a waiting list is developed for park or trail adoptions, a two year limit will apply.
2. "Enhancement" projects should be done in or along your section of park or trail at least once a month during the warm season, and as weather permits in the winter. Projects such as planting flowers and painting requires Parks Department approval. No approval is required for litter pick up, raking or cleaning items such as picnic tables, playground equipment, and benches.
3. The Adopting organization will receive a certificate, be recognized through City of Grand Island website, be listed in the annual Parks and Recreation program guide, and on the City's cable television channel.
